### **ITINERARY**

#### **MONDAY 21 SEPTEMBER 2020**

After a morning in Bowral make your way independently to Christchurch, New Zealand arriving late evening. Upon arrival in Christchurch you will be met and transferred to our hotel.

#### TUESDAY 22 SEPTEMBER (B.L.D.)

After our late evening arrival yesterday we have a relaxed start to the morning with breakfast at the hotel before departing for a day touring the greater Christchurch region with visits to several of the major local growers and hybridisers in the area including David & Leitha Adams and Aaron Russ. Enjoy lunch in the countryside and explore some of the great local gardens in the area as well.

#### WEDNESDAY 23 SEPTEMBER (B.L.D.)

This morning we set our sights southwards travelling across the Canterbury Plains to Geraldine. Departing from Geraldine our route takes us through to the expansive Mackenzie Basin which is surrounded by mountains and enjoys a continental climate as a result. The towering glaciated peaks of Aoraki Mt Cook National Park guide us past the turquoise Lakes Tekapo & Pukaki to our nights accommodation at internationally renowned Hermitage Hotel which sits within the National Park at the base of Mt Cook.

#### THURSDAY 24 SEPTEMBER (B.L. D.)

Enjoy the alpine environment this morning with several short walks to choose from that allow you to explore and appreciate the specialist alpine vegetation of New Zealand. We then drive along the banks of the Waitaki River passing several important Maori Rock Art sites before arriving at the coastal town of Oamaru. Tonight we enjoy dinner by the sea and one of the highlights of the journey which is the nightly return of the local Little Blue Penguins.

#### FRIDAY 25 SEPTEMBER (B.LD.)

There is time this morning to explore the historic streets of Oamaru with the iconic local Oamaru stone buildings now housing a fabulous collection of galleries and shops. Driving northwards through the rolling hills of North Otago we stop at internationally acclaimed Trotts Gardens before continuing northwards to arrive in Christchurch in time to meet with the exhibitors at the South Island National Daffodil Show in Christchurch and enjoy dinner with the local growers at the show.

#### **SATURDAY 26 SEPTEMBER (B.L.D.)**

Today is set aside to allow you to appreciate and enjoy the daffodils at the National Show, arrive at the show early in the morning to catch the hive of activity as the last staging is completed or arrive a little later and see the results of judging. This evening join with the members of the National Daffodil Society of New Zealand for the show dinner with presentation of trophies and awards.

#### **SUNDAY 27 SEPTEMBER (B.D.)**

Return this morning to the show to take a closer look at the flowers before heading out to North Canterbury to visit Michael & Marion Brown in Loburn. This evening enjoy a farewell dinner with local daffodil growers.

#### MONDAY 28 SEPTEMBER 2020 (B. D.)

Today has been set aside for you to either enjoy a free day in Christchurch exploring independently or take the opportunity to enjoy an iconic Canterbury experience with the choice of either the Tranz Alpine Train Journey through the Southern Alps to the West Coast of the South Island or travel northwards to Kaikoura and take a boat in search of Sperm Whales and marine life in the rich waters offshore from Kaikoura. Return to our accommodation in Christchurch this evening for a final group dinner. The optional tours today are an additional cost and should be pre-booked at the time of final payment.

TranzAlpine – full day including transfer from Hotel to Railway Station and return US\$195 - subject to confirmation on availability and confirmed rates at time of booking. Food will be available to purchase during the day.
